Consider These Statistics:

- 47 Washington County schools had more than 50% of their students eligible to receive free or reduce-cost lunch. One school had 91.33% eligible students
- Over 2400 children in Washington County below the age of 18 were considered homeless.
- 74% of households in Washington County reported incomes below the federal poverty line. 84% reported not having enough money to feed their families.
- By our 10th anniversary in 2015, Faith Cafe will have served over 100,000 meals.

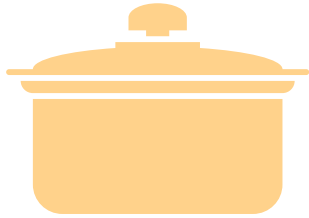
